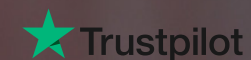

Our approach

Course Structure

Each course starts with a current understanding of a specific area of SEND before going on to share proven and practical assessment and intervention strategies. Authentic case study videos demonstrate how students across the educational stages access learning and thrive.

Course tasks

Our online content is blended with live tutor sessions and online forum discussions to reinforce knowledge and robustly challenge existing practice and perspectives. As part of the course, participants complete an authentic case study task – the Goal and Action Plan (GAP). GAP fosters confidence in creating SMART goals and interventions, and also provides tutors with useful touchpoints to discuss reasonable adjustments and inclusive practice.

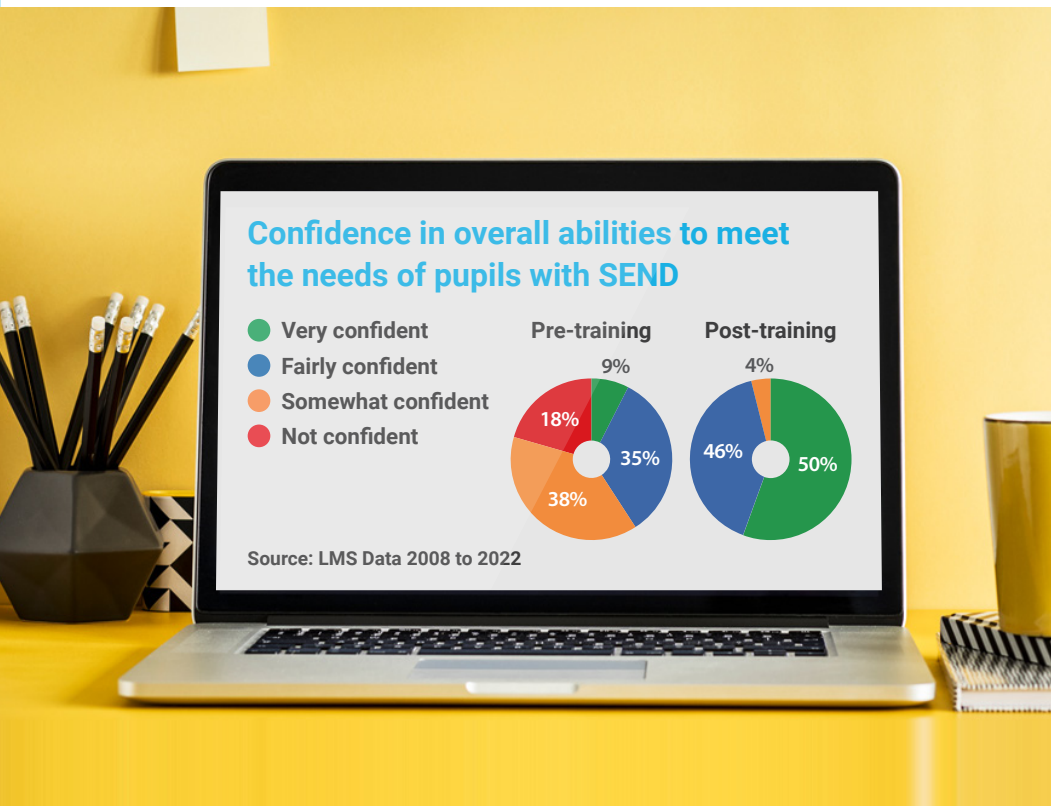

Management tools for Service Leads

Our comprehensive Learning Management System (LMS) makes monitoring and reporting on the training impact quick and simple. Built-in evaluation reports show the impact on staff knowledge, skills and confidence as well as the reported impact on pupil outcomes.

Our Goal Attainment Survey is the 'holy grail' of training impact!

90 days after completing a course, participants are asked to evaluate the impact of their Goal and Action Plan (GAP). Visualisations of this feedback data help service leads and tutors quickly determine the impact of our training on the pupil and participant's learning outcomes.

Eligibility

We have high expectations of our licenced tutors. So, we work with the education, health and care professionals, who normally provide SEND support to schools and colleges. To qualify for our tutor training programme, we ask that you:

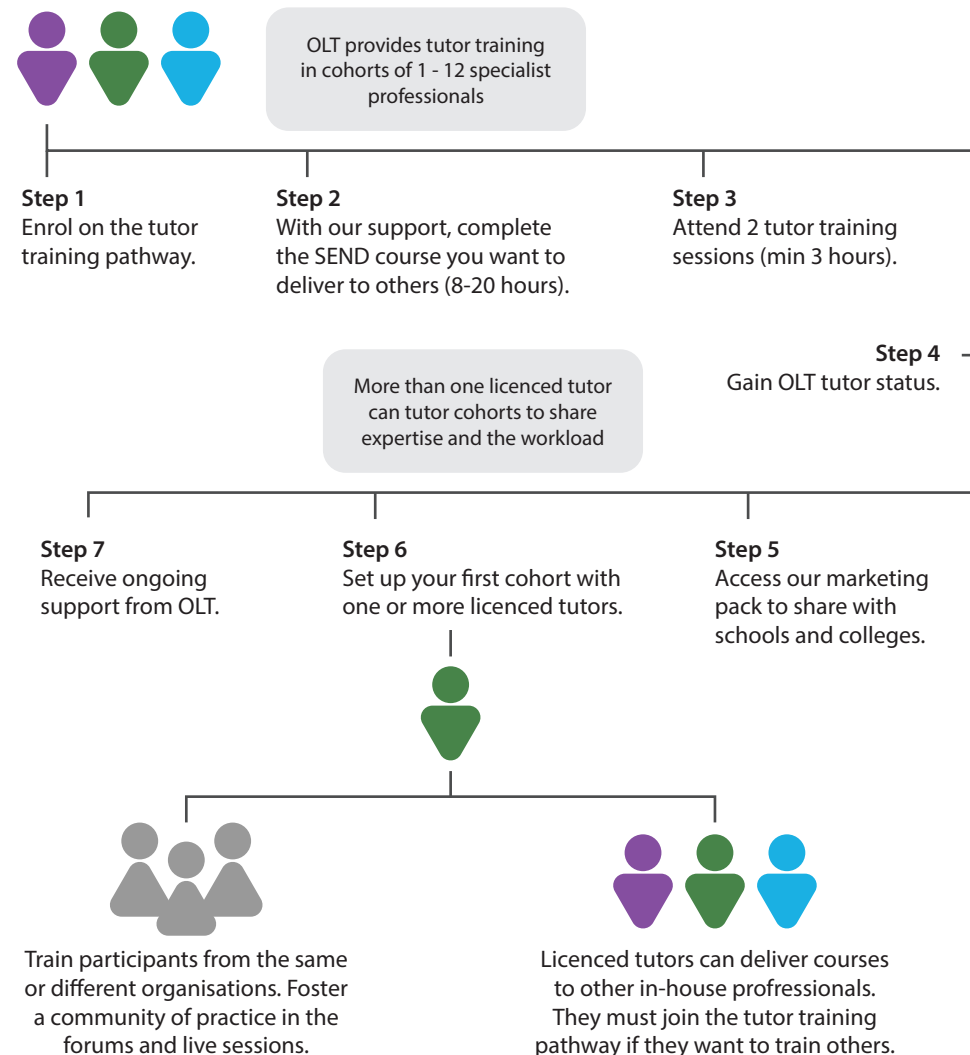
- ♥ have relevant qualifications and experience
- ♥ are a Teacher of the Deaf (TOD), Qualified Teacher of the Visually Impaired (QTVI) or Qualified Teacher of children with Multi-Sensory Impairment (QTMSI), if you want to deliver our sensory courses, as per our agreement with NatSIP
- ♥ complete 100% of the course that relates to your professional practice, and that you want to deliver to others
- ♥ attend tutor training sessions to comprehend OLT's standards for learning and assessment, and how to use our learning management system

Time commitment

The tutor training programme aims to familiarise you with OLT's course content and delivery approach so you can feel confident about cascading our training to others.

- Up to 23 hours over 1 to 3 months with a minimum of two virtual tutor training sessions, or
- Up to 20 hours online, one 3-hour face-to-face session at your setting

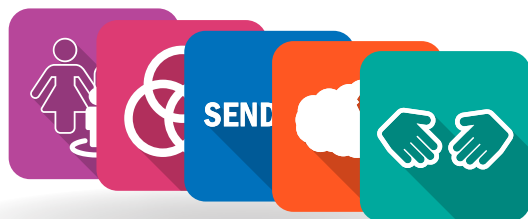
