This Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement is a response to Section 54(1), Part 6 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and relates to actions and activities for the financial year ending 31 May 2024.

As part of our efforts to monitor and reduce the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring in our supply chain, our due diligence procedure aims to:

- Identify and action potential risks in our business and supply chains.
- Monitor potential risks in our business and supply chains.
- Reduce the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring in our business and supply chains.

Risk and compliance

The Company has evaluated the nature and extent of its exposure to the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring in its UK supply chain by checking that any new suppliers have appropriate policies in place.

We do not consider that we operate in a high-risk environment because our supply chain is based in the first world in low-risk industries, such as internet software and services.

We do not tolerate slavery and human trafficking in our supply chain. Where there is evidence of failure to comply with our procedures by any of our suppliers, we will seek to terminate our relationship with that supplier immediately.

Effectiveness

We will keep this policy under review annually and in response to any significant changes in our supply chain.
