
### Asking a question

You can conveniently access Daisy on all UK paid course pages. Remember, Daisy's responses are confined to the course material!


1. Log in to your course and click on one of the course sections e.g., Understanding section

  - Summarise the main points on this page
  - Tell me how this strategy could be applied to my teaching practice?
  - Test your knowledge by generating a quiz for most course pages
  
4. It may take Daisy a couple of seconds to formulate her response. You will see a buffering circle as she crafts it.



5. Daisy's response appears in a blue box, and you have the option of continuing the conversation, if you require further clarification on the same or new topics.




6. Click the down arrow to close Daisy's chat function and return to the course page.

1. If your tutor has enabled this feature, Daisy (Virtual Assistant) will automatically and promptly respond to your post within 30 seconds.




2. If you reply to her comment, she will continue to engage in the conversation and provide further responses.




## Turning Daisy (VA) off
